Evaluation:

There is no examination but a term paper of at least 30 pages with all academic criteria. This paper will be 70% of the final mark. Papers must be submitted in the final date. Any late submissions will be punished with 20% of the final mark. The class participation and presentation of the paper is 30% of the final mark. Moreover, students also have to keep up with the TV Programmes outlined below to participate in class discussions.

This course intends to examine the discussions on the New World Order and its implications on the European Security since the end of the Cold War. Therefore, the discussions on the New World Order starting from 1917 and onwards will serve as a focal point. NATO, ESDI and the other regional security organizations and developments are subject to be discussed. In addition to this, the development of Turkish security policy perceptions under this new political, economical and military environment will be discussed and evaluated. In particular, the new security perceptions and theories will be part of the seminar.

Important note: Students are expected to keep up with weekly readings and to participate actively in the class discussions. Attendance is compulsory. Late students will not be admitted to the classroom . until the first break. Students whose cellular phones ring in the class will be asked to leave immediately, so turn them off before entering the classroom.
